PRACTICE DIRECTIONS
PRESIDENTIAL ELECTION PETITION 1 OF 2017:
RAILA AMOLO ODINGA & ANOTHER V INDEPENDENT ELECTORAL
COMMISSION & 2 OTHERS

IN exercise of the powers conferred by rule 25 of the Supreme Court (Presidential Election Petition) Rules, 2017 and in respect of the Supreme Court Presidential Election Petition 1 of 2017, Raila Amolo Odinga & another v Independent Electoral & Boundaries Commission & 2 others, the Chief Justice and President Supreme Court of Kenya issues the following practice directions:

1. The Petitioners should file and serve their written submissions on the Petition by 1.00 pm on Friday 25th August 2017.
2. The Respondents should file and serve their written submissions by 7.00 pm on Friday 25th August 2017.
3. Should the Petitioners wish to file a rejoinder to the Respondents' written submissions, they should file and serve the same by 9.00 am on Saturday 26th August 2017.
4. Any party wishing to file an application relating to this Petition should file and serve their application together with the written submissions limited to five pages by 1.00 pm on Friday August 25th 2017.
5. Responses to any such applications should be filed and served together with written submissions if any thereon, by 7.00 pm on August 25th 2017.
6. Any party wishing to be admitted to the Petition, as *amicus curiae* should pursuant to Rule 54 of the Supreme Court Rules, 2012, file and serve their application together with the *amicus* brief by 1.00 pm on August 25th 2017.
